

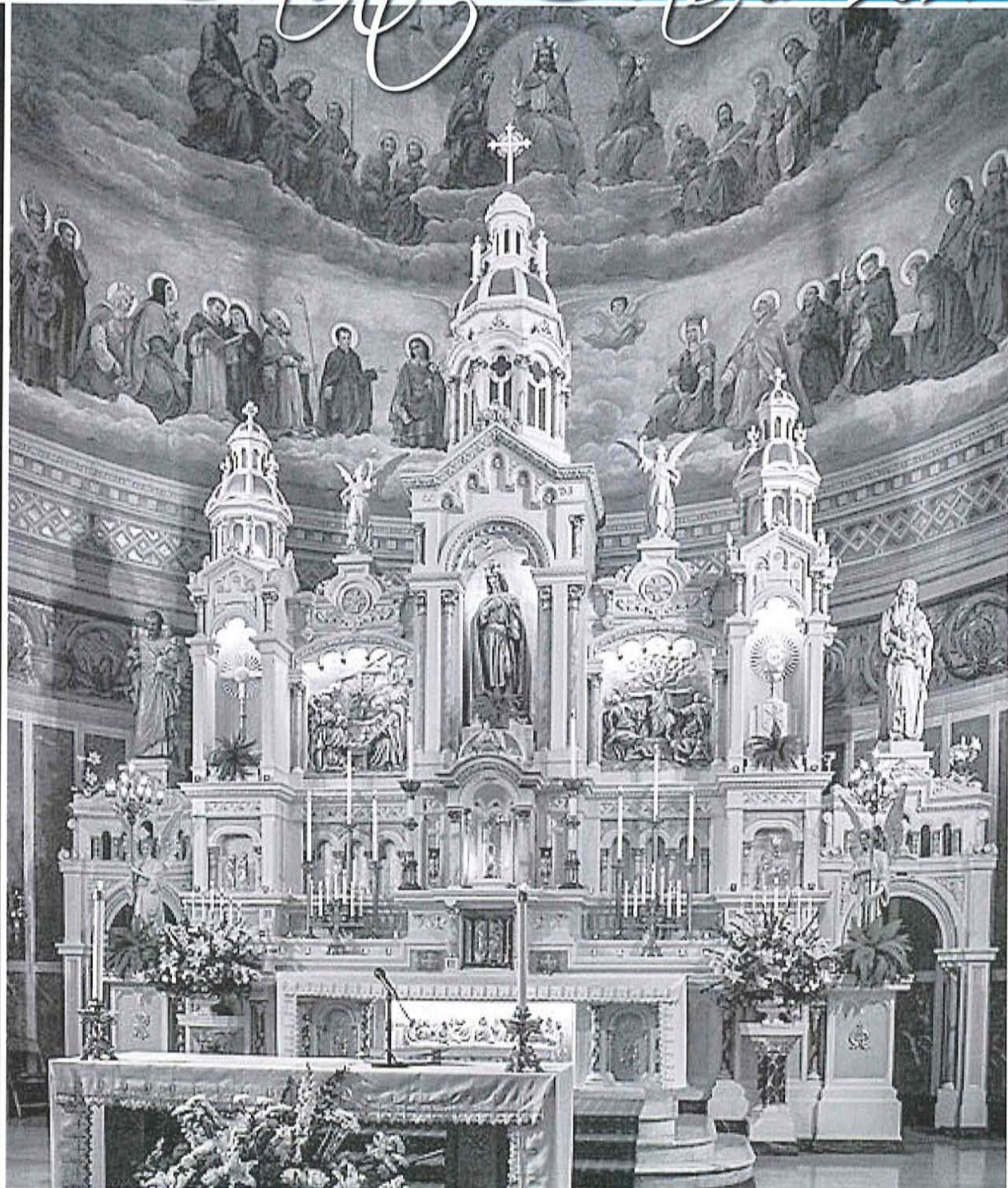

VISIT OF + CARDINAL RYLKO, May 21st

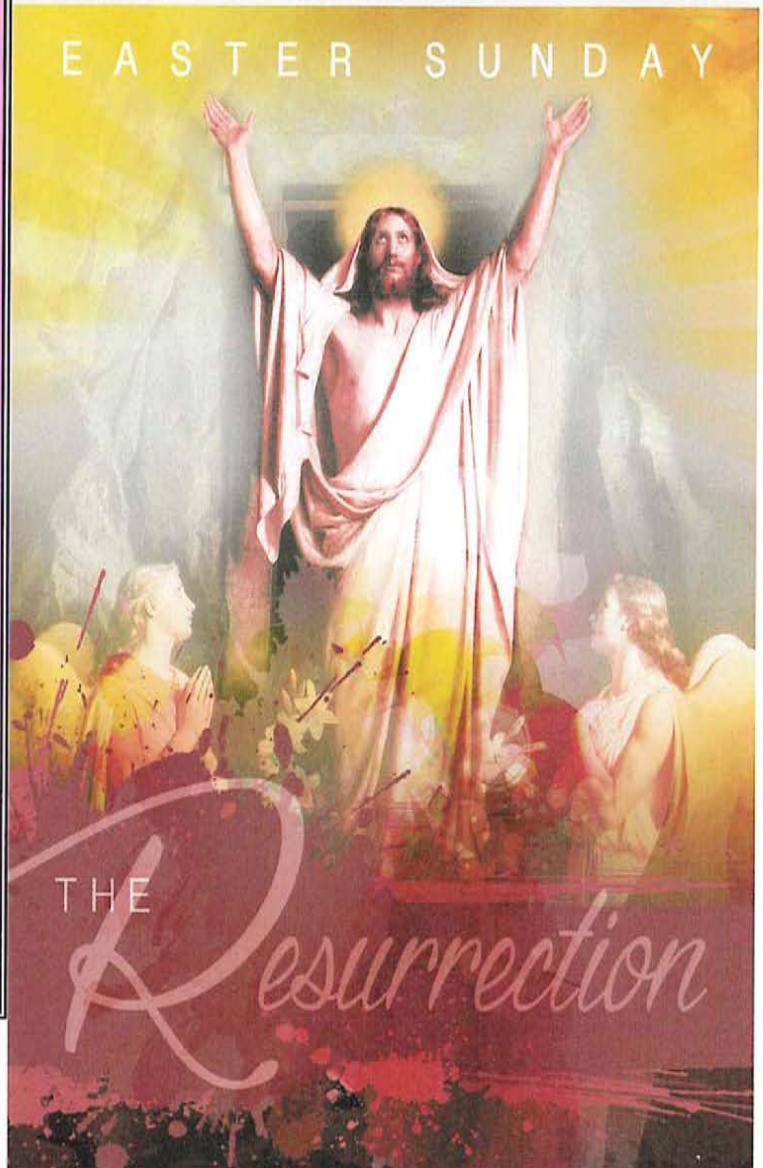
