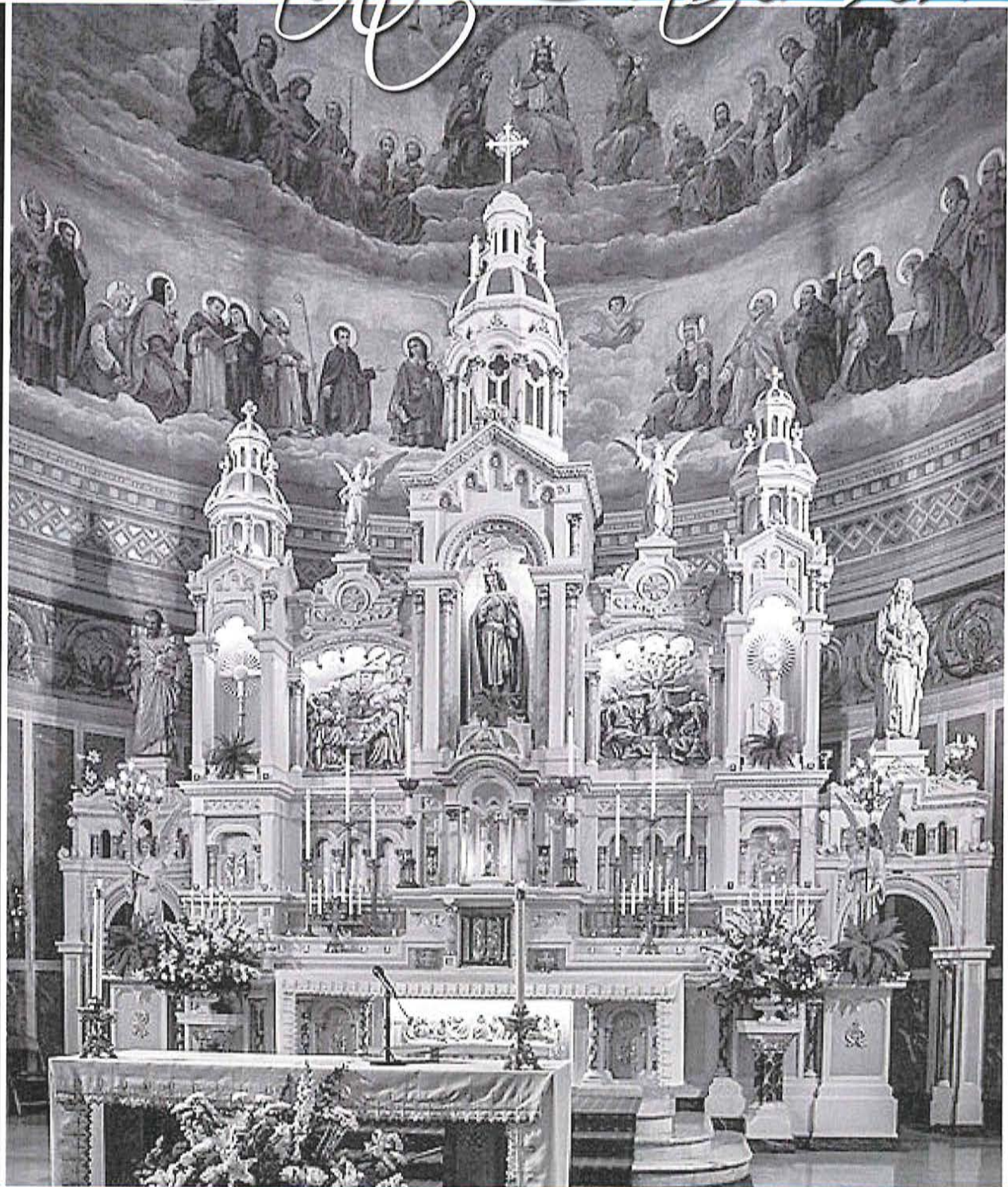

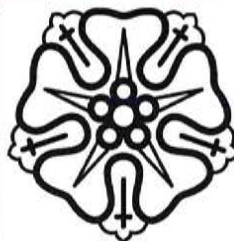

### FATHER'S DAY, June 16th

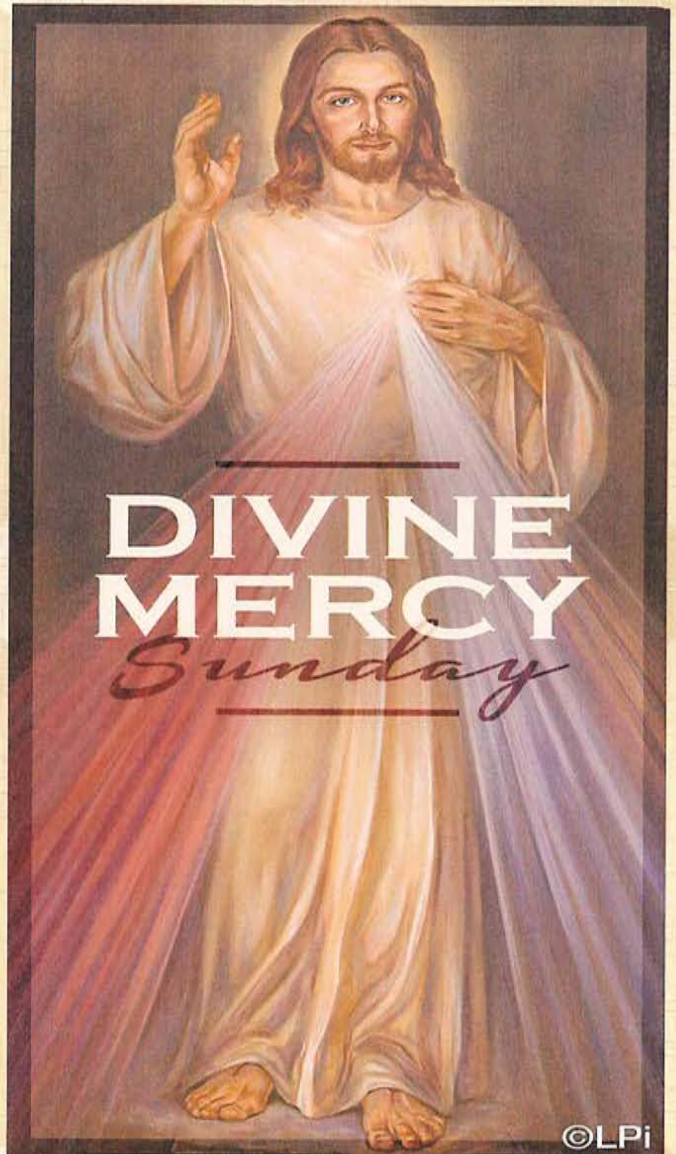
Mass for our living and deceased Fathers at 11:30AM followed by a festive luncheon in the Social Hall.
