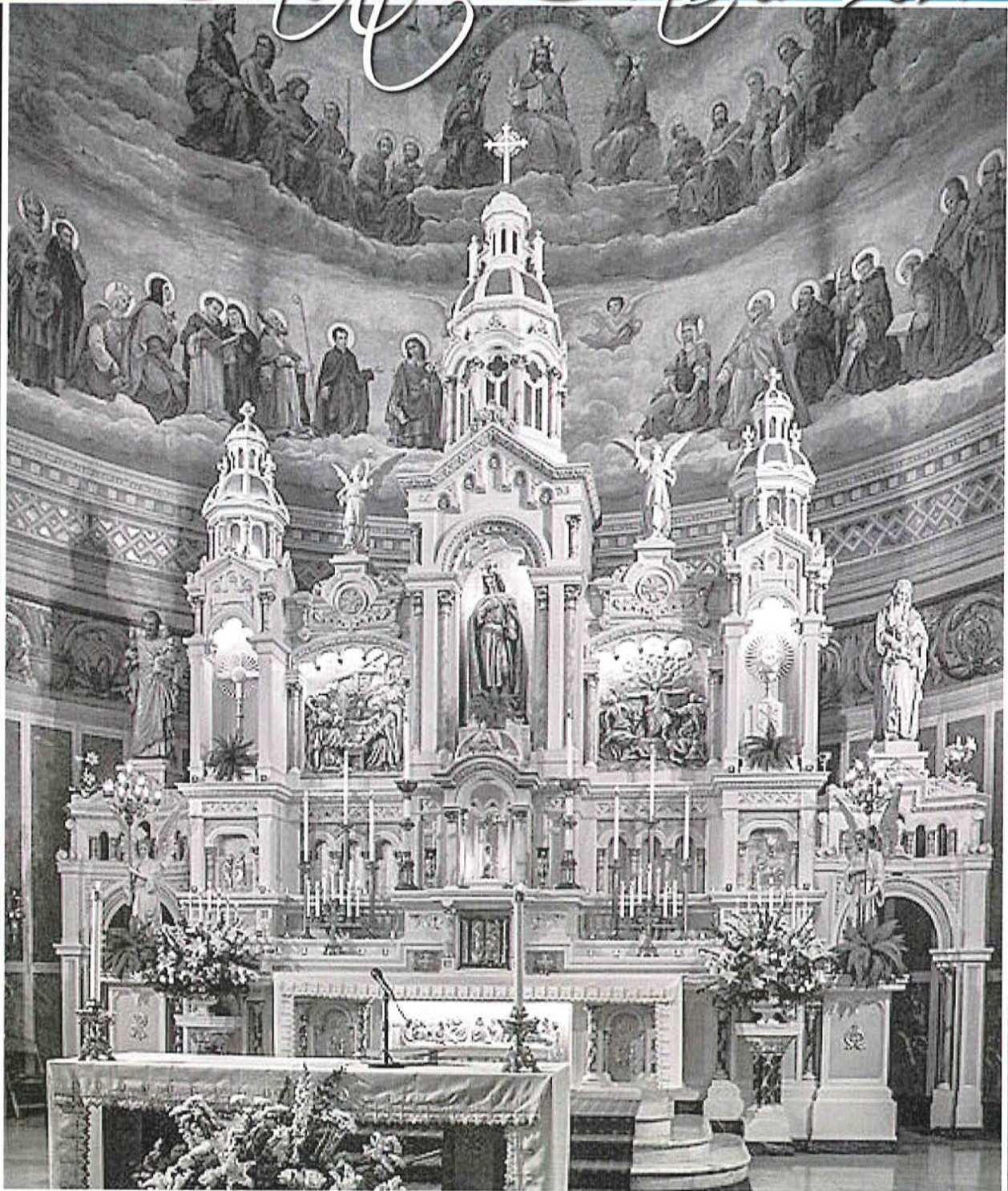

SOME SPECIAL ANNOUNCEMENTS...

The Visit of Cardinal Rylko... is fast approaching. His Eminence, who serves at the Archpriest of the Basilica of St. Mary Major in Rome and Chairman of the Administrative Council of the Pope John Paul II Foundation, will be making his first visit to Cleveland from Monday, May 20th to Wednesday afternoon, May 22nd.

There will be two major public events associated with the Cardinal's visit, a Solemn Mass and Banquet on Tuesday, May 21st, and a fundraising luncheon on Wednesday, May 22nd. Many invitations have already been sent in the mail to those on various Polonia mailing list.

First, at 6PM on the 21st the Cardinal will offer a Solemn Mass at the Shrine Church of St. Stanislaus. We certainly hope that there will be a large turn-out from Cleveland Polonia, especially from out fraternal, cultural, and veteran organizations. It is always inspiring to see Polonia come together for such events. Immediately following the Mass, everyone is invited to the Gala Banquet at the Bohemian National Hall right down the street on Broadway Avenue. Tickets are \$50 per person and all proceeds will benefit the Foundation.

Second, the Cardinal will offer a more intimate Mass on Wednesday morning at 10AM at St. Stanislaus followed by a fundraising luncheon for the Foundation hosted by the Polish American Cultural Center on Lansing Avenue. With limited seating, this event will offer a wonderful chance to spend time with the Cardinal and hear of our Saintly Holy Father's vision for the Foundation which bears his name.

SANCTUARY LAMP INTENTIONS
