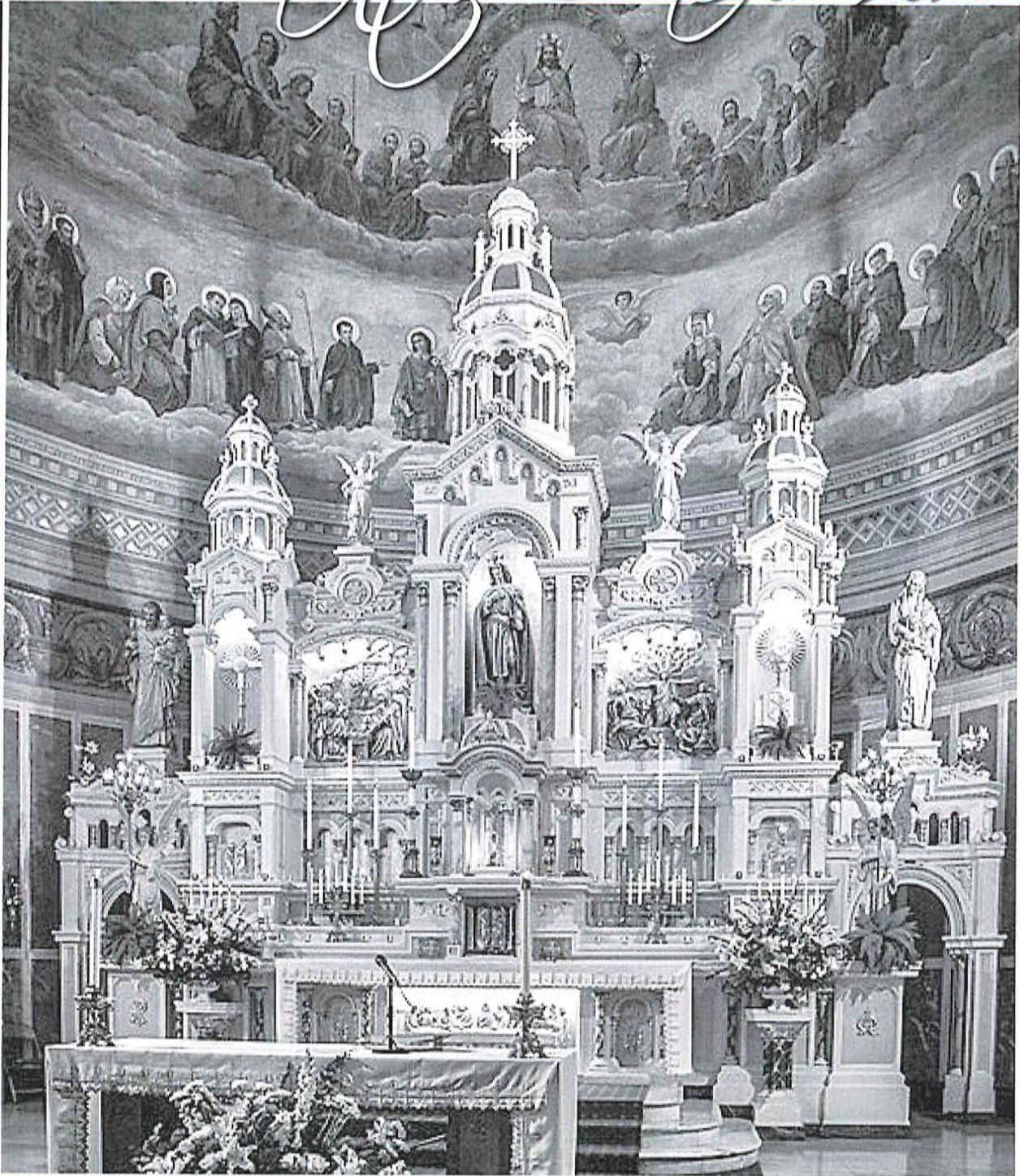

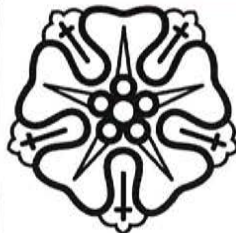

We welcome the internationally traveling St. John Paul II triptych with its first class relics on both these weekends. Our reflections will focus on the themes of St. John Paul's teachings and two great devotions in his life and pontificate - to our blessed Mother, Mary, and St. Faustyna and the Divine Mercy. Also, on May 2nd, Polish Constitution Day and the Feast of Mary, Queen of Poland will be commemorated.
