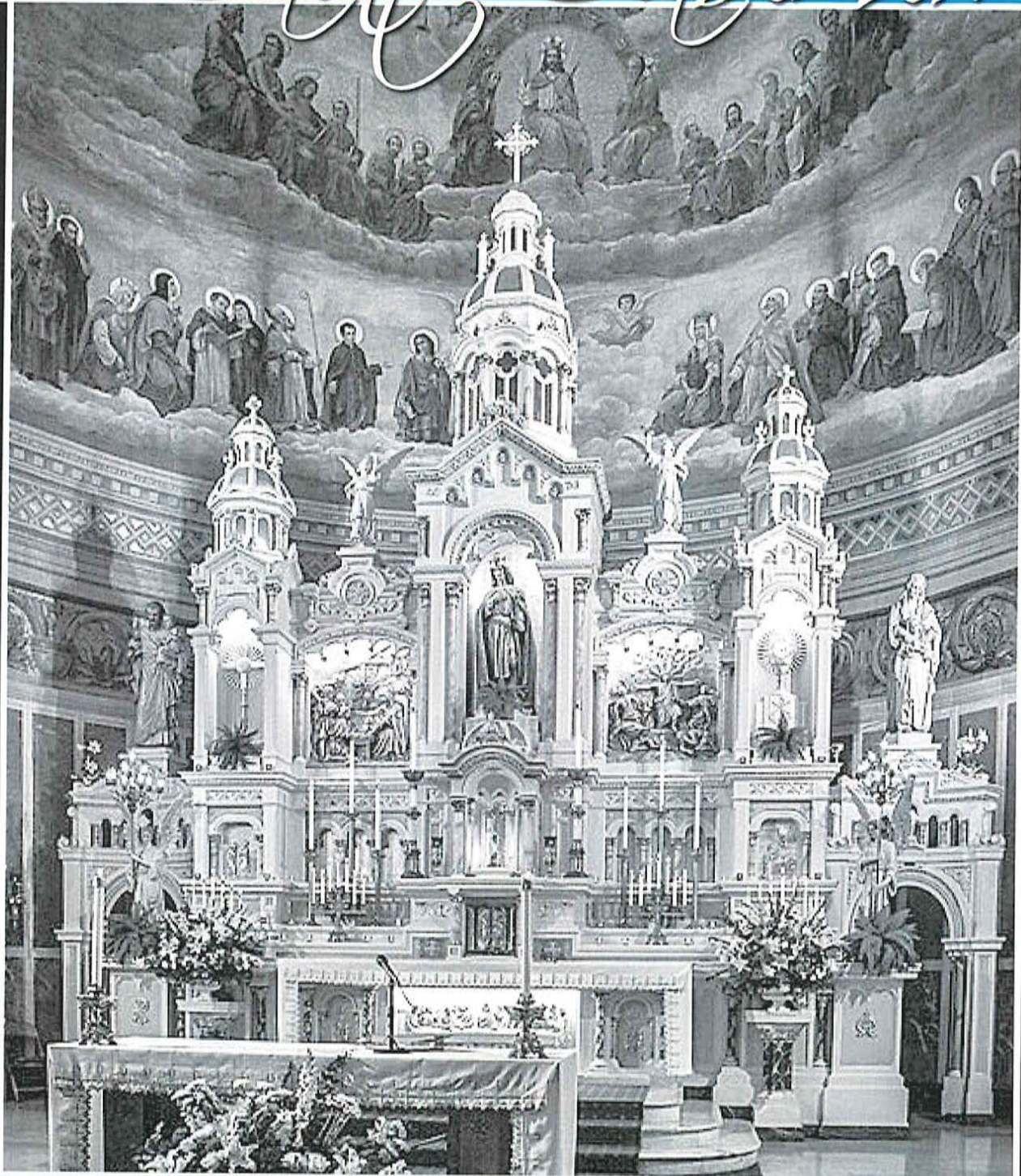

May 23rd - FEAST OF PENTECOST. Fifty days after Easter we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit and the birth day of the Church. Solemn Mass at 11:30AM.

May 30th—TRINITY SUNDAY. The Church celebrates today the principal mystery of our Faith: that God is One yet in three persons—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Solemn Mass at 11:30AM.

EASTERTIDE

Feast of Pentecost, May 23rd

Our 11:30AM Mass celebrates the "birthday of the Church" on this fiftieth day after Easter when the Holy Spirit came upon the Apostles to enliven them for proclaiming the Good News to the ends of the Earth.

Trinity Sunday, May 30th

Our 11:30AM Mass observes today the foundational mystery of our Faith: that God is one but in three distinct persons—the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

Feast of Corpus Christi, June 6th

Out Solemn celebrations begin with a festive Mass at 11:30AM followed by Eucharistic Devotions at the main altar. From there, we will have the traditional procession to the three decorated altars around our campus: at the Convent, the School, and concluding at the Grotto. Services will alternate between English and Polish. We're one of the few parishes that still observes this wonderful tradition. JOIN US!!!

May is the Month of Mary...and, once again, our parish will honor our Lady by singing the Litany of Loreto after each Sunday Mass, alternating between English and Polish. Today, the Litany will be sung in English and the text can be found on the printed sheets in the Church.

A Special Second Collection...will be taken-up TODAY in support of the Office of Catechetical Services and the Newman Campus Ministries. These funds help programs & initiatives which support the promotion of our Faith throughout the Diocese. The Bishop-Ordinaries in the State of Ohio...have together decreed for all their dioceses that, given the recent announcement of our Governor and the CDC, as of the weekend of Corpus Christi, June 5th/6th, the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holydays is **hereby reinstated** and the special dispensation in effect during the pandemic dispensing us from that obligation is **now rescinded**.
