

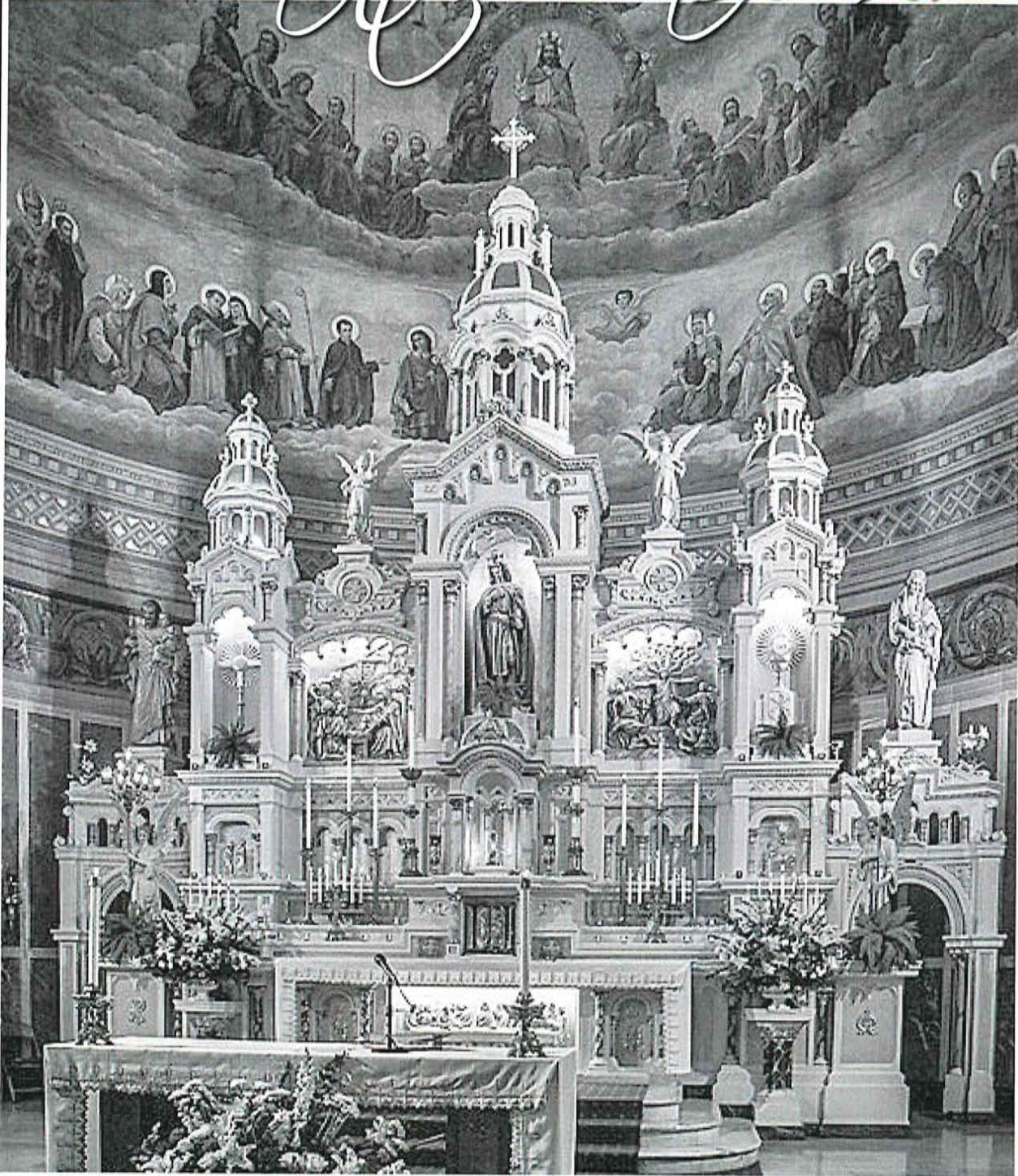

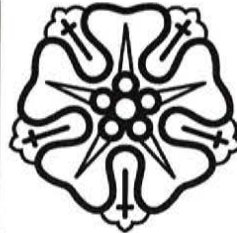

Memorial Remembrances

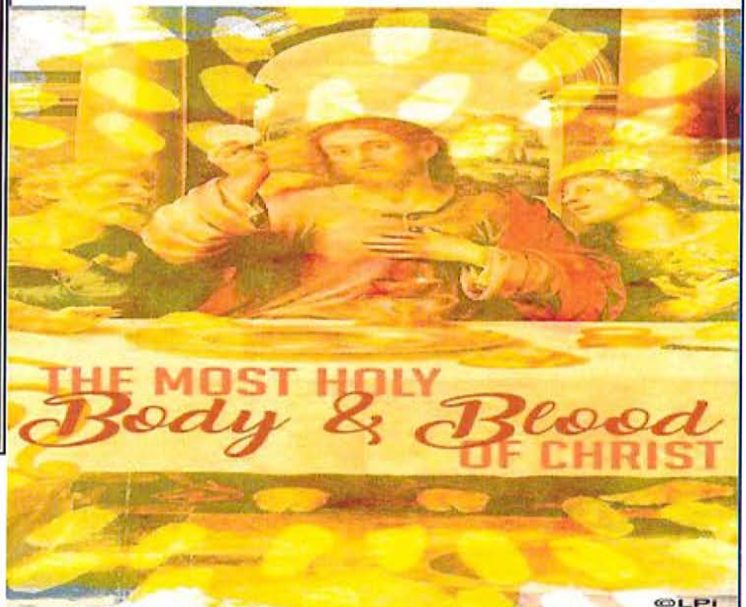

June is the Month of the Sacred Heart...and as is our custom, we will sing the Litany of the Sacred Heart at the end of each Sunday Mass in June, rotating between Polish and English....with the exception of this Sunday, as it is Corpus Christi.

The Bishop-Ordinaries in the State of Ohio...have together decreed for all their dioceses that, given the recent announcement of our Governor and the CDC, as of the weekend of Corpus Christi, **TO-DAY**, June 6th, the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holydays is hereby reinstated and the special dispensation in effect during the pandemic dispensing us from that obligation is now rescinded. We also resume today "normal" operations as the pandemic restrictions are now also lifted.
