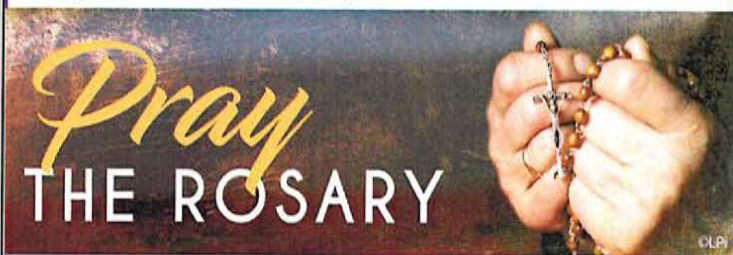
### Memorial Remembrances
