



Memorial Day is an American holiday, observed on the last Monday of May, honoring the men and women who died while serving in the U.S. military. Memorial Day 2022 will occur on Monday, May 30. Originally known as Decoration Day, it originated in the years following the Civil War and became an official federal holiday in 1971.

Many Americans observe Memorial Day by visiting cemeteries or memorials, holding family gatherings and participating in parades. A special Memorial Day Mass will be at 9AM at St. Stanislaus Church to which all are invited praying in thanksgiving for the gift of our freedom and those who sacrificed so we may enjoy it.
