TRANSFIGURATION

OF THE LORD

This Saturday, August 6th, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Transfiguration of our Lord. The Gospel account tells of Jesus appearing in glory on Mount Tabor together with Moses and Elijah, representing the Law and the Prophets of the Old Testament. Chronologically, this event took place shortly before Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem which was followed by His passion, suffering, and death. This event served as a kind of "sneak preview" to the representative apostles - Peter, James, and John - and was meant to strengthen their faith during these upcoming trying times so that they would endure and grow with the help of the coming Holy Spirit. It was meant to do the very same for all of us because we, too, need our faith strengthened from time to time when we struggle with the trials of life. This Feast reminds us that Jesus knows and He cares and has gone to lengths such as the Transfiguration to assure all of us of His presence, love, and support - especially when we feel that it may not be there.
