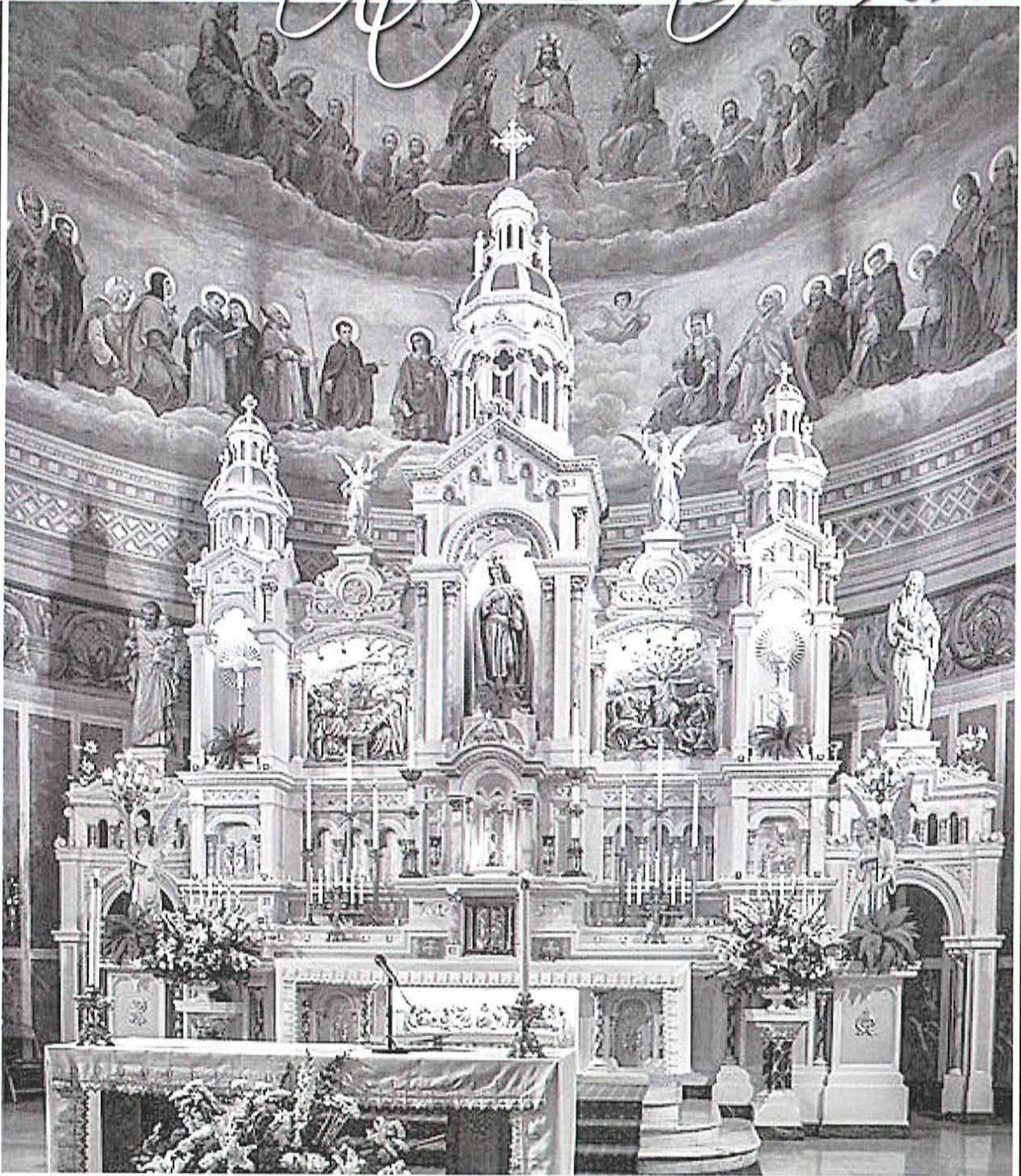

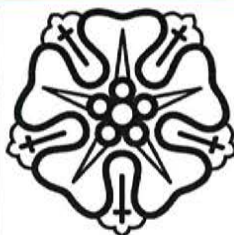

### **MOTHER'S DAY & MAY CROWNING - MAY 14TH**

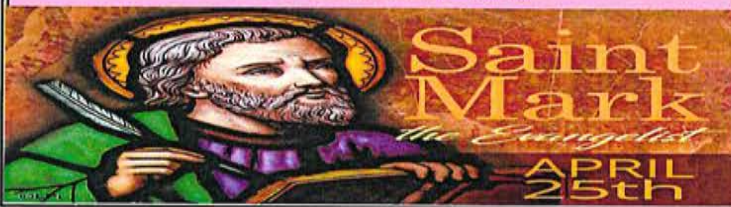
Following the 11:30AM Mass for the intentions of our living and deceased Mothers will be a procession to the Convent Marian Shrine for our annual May Crowning.
