

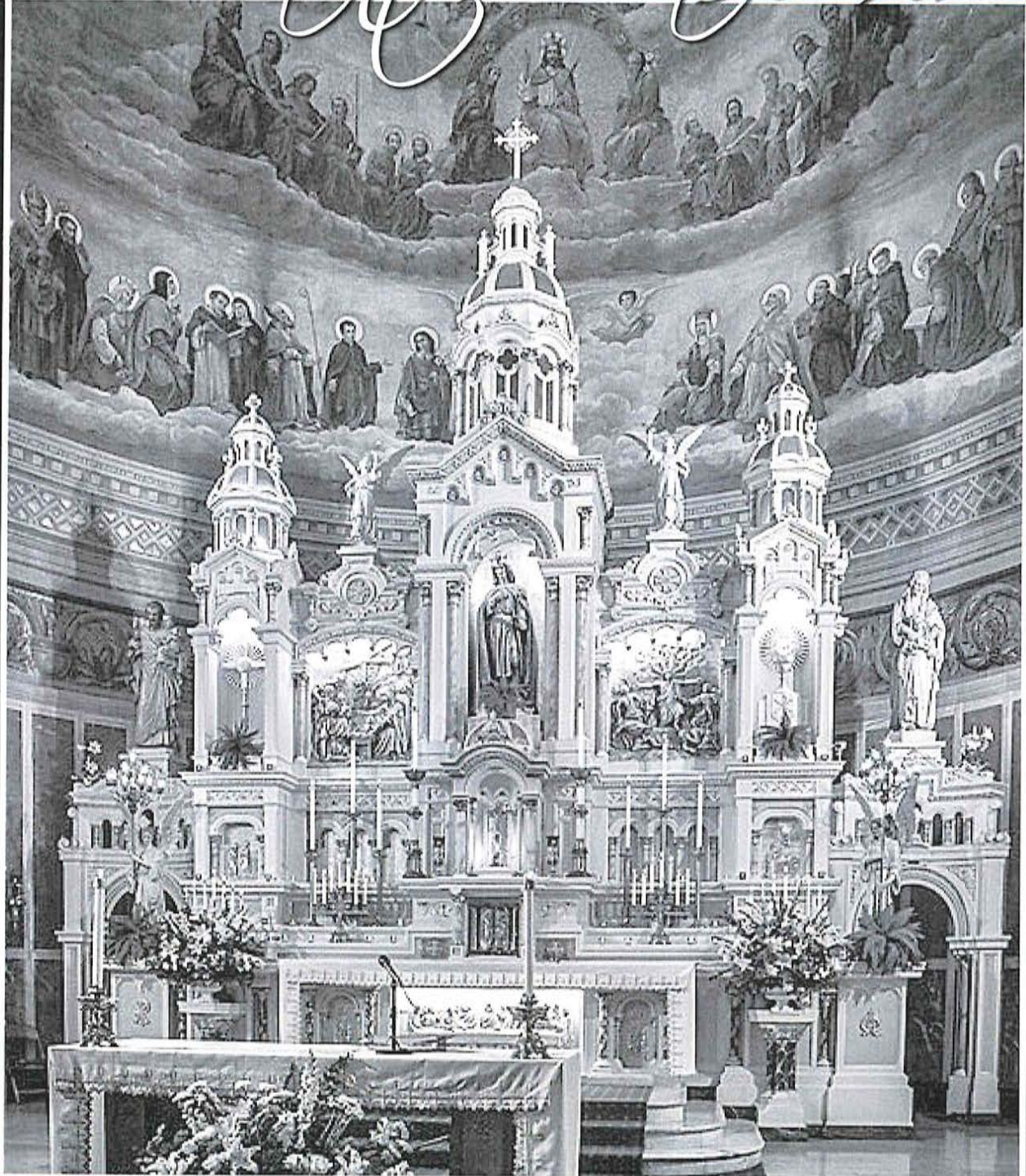

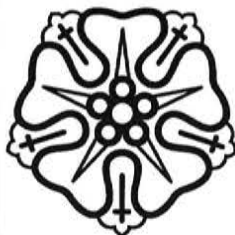

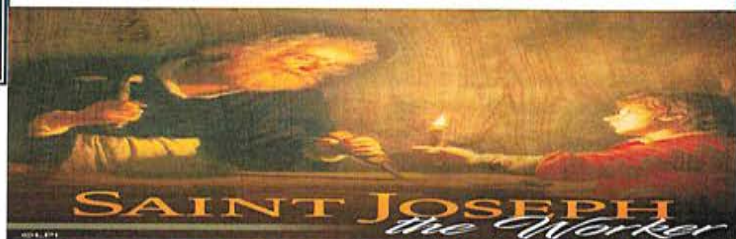
SOME SPECIAL ANNOUNCEMENTS...
