




MOTHER'S DAY, MAY 12TH - TODAY

On the Feast of the Ascension of our Lord we also observe Mother's Day. May Crowning will take place following the 11:30AM Mass with a procession to the Convent Shrine. Who will be this year's May Queen?!?! A festive luncheon to treat Mom will be immediately after in the Social Hall.

FEAST OF PENTECOST, MAY 19TH

On the fiftieth day after Easter, we celebrate the appropriately named Feast of Pentecost which marks the liturgical end of the Easter Season. The descent of the Holy Spirit upon Mary and the Apostles in the Upper Room is also recognized as the "birthday of the Church". A festive Mass and celebration will be at 11:30AM.

FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI - JUNE 2ND

On this special day dedicated to the Holy Eucharist - during this time of Eucharistic Revival in our Nation - we will have a solemn Mass at 11:30AM followed by the traditional procession and devotions at the outdoor altars, each beautifully decorated by different groups from our Parish. From Church we process to the Convent steps, then to the School steps, and then to the Grotto...and finally to the Social Hall for a nice luncheon afterward!

SANCTUARY LIGHT INTENTIONS
